## **Invitation to the 14<sup>th</sup> Klausberg ICE GAMES**

### **International snow sculpture competition in Ahrntal valley**

Dear Sir or Madam! Dear artist

After the further success from the 13th edition last year, we are happy to inform you that the **International snow sculpture competition** goes to the next round. From Sunday, 14th January to Friday, 19th January 2024 the ski area Klausberg in Steinhaus/ Ahrntal valley will become a large atelier where no restrictions are placed to the fantasy. The aim of this competition is to create a sculpture at a height of 2500 m above sea level with a marvelous view on the "Zillertaler Alps" with the subject "**Chess - newly interpreted**" from a block of snow with the size of 3x3x3 m.

Every sculpture will be valued by a jury of experts and the winners will receive great prizes (net):

1<sup>st</sup> price: €770,00

2<sup>nd</sup> price: €605,00

3<sup>rd</sup> price: €440,00

4<sup>th</sup> price: €330,00

5<sup>th</sup> price: €275,00

6<sup>th</sup> price: €220,00

We are glad to welcome you at the **14<sup>th</sup> International snow sculpture competition** in the **ski area Klausberg in Steinhaus/ Ahrntal valley** and we are waiting with great interest for your ideas about these snow sculptures.

Please let us have your registration form with a sketch, the title of your planned work and all other necessary documents at the latest on the 15th November 2023. The senders of the 10 best sketches will be selected to participate.

## Reglement

### Organizer and topic

The Ahrntal Valley-Ahrntal Tourist Association is organizing the snow sculpture competition in the ski area Klausberg in Steinhaus/Ahrntal valley about the topic **"Chess – newly interpreted"** from the 14th January to the 19th January 2024. The snow sculptures should have a certain stability, so that they can be admired as long as possible.

### Participants

Sculptors from all over the world have the possibility to join the competition. The sculptors can participate in a team. The 10 attending teams can consist of maximum 2 people (of legal age). Groups of pupils (2 people) accompanied by an adult teacher can be a part to the event as well.

### Appointments: Tender | selection of the artists

15th November 2023 – closing date for registration: handing out the fully filled in registration form with title, sketch and/or photo with a short description of the planned object, Curriculum vitae, reference objects (optional).

End of November: Selection of the participants through organizing committee and jury of experts with certificate of participation or refusal.

### Obligations of the organizing committee

1. Free food and accommodation for the participants for the period of 14<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> January 2024
2. The six first placed sculptors will receive an additional cash prize.
3. Travel cost refunding: All partaking teams will receive a contribution towards cost of € 0,20 (net) per km from the hometown to the venue. The maximum amount for teams from Europe is €280,00 (net), teams from other continents will get a maximum amount of €520,00 (net).
4. Care by specialists
5. Evaluation by jury of experts
6. Certificate of participation
7. Framework program

Eventual extras (bar, telephone, drinks) will not be refunded.

### Snow blocks

The snow blocks (3m long, 3m wide, 3m high) will be allotted to the team on 14<sup>th</sup> January 2024.

### Equipment

The snow sculptures have to be formed of snow, ice and water. The organizers will place the following tools at the disposal for the teams: 2 shovels, 1 ladder, 1 bucket and 1 pick. Each participant can additionally bring his own equipment.

### Working hours

Daily from 8.30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The works have to be completed within 18<sup>th</sup> January 2024 until approx. 3 p.m.

### Insurance

The organizer refuses any third part responsibility. Insurance is to be arranged by the participants.

### Prizes

The winner will be selected by a jury of experts on 18<sup>th</sup> January 2024 (afternoon). The six first placed sculptors will be rewarded with cash prizes:

1<sup>st</sup> price: €770,00  
2<sup>nd</sup> price: €605,00  
3<sup>rd</sup> price: €440,00

4<sup>th</sup> price: €330,00  
5<sup>th</sup> price: €275,00  
6<sup>th</sup> price: €220,00
